DEFINITION

NET FLOWS are disbursements minus principal repayments

DISBURSEMENT are drawings on loan commitments during the year specified

FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT is defined as investment that is made to acquire a lasting management interest (usually 10 percent of voting stock)

in an enterprise operating in a country other than that of the investor (defined according to residency), the investor's purpose being an

effective voice in the management of the enterprise. It is the sum of equity capital, reinvestment of earnings, other long-term capital, and short-term capital as shown in the balance of payments.

GRANTS are defined as legally binding commitments that obligate a specific value of funds available for disbursement for which there is no repayment requirement.

CONCESSIONAL LOANS are loans from official lenders on concessional terms as defined by the DAC, that is, loans with an original grant element of at least 25 per cent.

NB loans from the World Bank and the African, Asian and Inter-American Development Banks are classified as concessional according to each institution's own classification, and not according to the DAC definition as in earlier reports.

NOTES

1. Bolivia has received US\$460 million in ODA relief from the Japanese Government
2. Burkina Faso's HIPC debt relief includes US\$129 million in topping up relief. The stock of debt at the Decision Point under the original HIPC initiative was US\$833 million, revised to US\$860 million at the second Decision Point.
3. Ethiopia HIPC relief includes US\$ 706.9 million in topping up relief
4. Honduras Completion Point document is still not available
5. Niger's HIPC debt relief includes Topping Up at Completion Point
6. Rwanda's HIPC relief includes US\$343.1 million in topping up relief
